2020 IMPACT REPORT

OUR PATH OF HOPE IN 2020:

Nick Hundley's Baseball Camp - Partnered with MLB coaches and San Diego Christian College's baseball team to teach 80 kids how to play baseball.

Served at Laurel Elementary Feed San Diego food distributions and helped staff recess.

Helped the book of Genesis come alive for our HLA kids by taking them to the Creation Museum in Santee.



Partnered with Trust Restaurants and distributed 3,500 individual meals during quarantine.

COVID Collection Campaign- Worked with Santa Fe Christian students to deliver groceries and \$50 gift cards to 30 struggling families downtown.

Launched virtual tutoring and mentoring program, providing HLA kids with educational, emotional and spiritual support.



Grace Digital enabled us to donate 350+ pairs of headphones to King-Chavez students for distance learning.

School Gear for the New Year- We filled 120 backpacks with school supplies for students at King Chavez and Laurel Elementary.

Held our 1st group outreach post-quarantine and took 20 kids to The Plunge Pool in Belmont Park for an end of the summer celebration.



HLA expanded to Escondido! Hosted a free 5-week Day Camp at ECHS with guest speakers- Chantelle Anderson & Nick Hundley.

Provided gift cards for 36 families to purchase Thanksgiving meals.

Toys for Hope Build & Bless...Volunteers built and delivered Christmas-in-a-box to 600 families in SD County. Each box had toys, groceries, household essentials & The Jesus Film.

Wrapped up 2020 with hikes at Torrey Pines and Cabrillo National Park.
